STANDARD UNIFORM ATTIRE:

Top Options:

- **Polo shirt** in royal blue, grey, or white.
- Long-sleeved polo may be worn in royal blue.
- School logo preferred, but not required










Bottom Options:

- Slack pants in gray or black
- Slack shorts in gray or black
- Skorts in gray or plaid
- Skirts in gray or plaid
 - (Modesty/bike shorts are required) <u>underneath</u>)



- Black sweater options in cardigan, v-neck, or vest
- Black fleece jacket, rain jacket, or insulated jacket
- No logos other than the school logo. School logo preferred but not required.





PE UNIFORM ATTIRE:

*may only be worn during PE

Top Options:

- OCASA Spirit t-shirt
- Or **Band Level** t-shirt (Green for 6th grade, Teal for 7th -8th)



Outwear Options:

- Hooded Pull-Over or Zip-Up Sweatshirt in Royal Blue, Grey, or White
- No logos other than the school logo



Bottom Options:

- Black mesh gym shorts with elastic waistband or,
- Black pull-on sweatpants







BAND LEVEL

OCASA does not want uniform purchases to be a barrier for any family. If finances are a concern when it comes to ordering uniforms, please confidentially message your principal or Paul D'Ambrosio, Community Outreach Manager via ParentSquare for scholarship options. Uniforms may be purchased from any vendor as long as they match the color and style requirements outlined. The school logo is not required on any item.

FORMAL UNIFORM ATTIRE

The formal uniform is worn on **Thursdays, as well as on picture day, at school assemblies, and for other special events**. Dates will be announced in advance.

Top Options:

- White short or long-sleeved Oxford shirt with school logo
- Plaid tie or black cross-over tie





Bottom Options:

Same as standard uniform

Outwear Options:

Same as standard uniform



- **Socks** can be white, gray, black, or royal (no higher than below the knee)
- Closed-toed shoes in gray, black, white, or royal
- Plaid/matching hair accessories
- Black or brown belt









Reminders:

Hats or beanies are not allowed in classrooms.
They may be worn to school but must be taken off before entering the building.





- No jeans or denim allowed. Uniforms must be clean, neat, and in good condition—no ripped pants.
- Leggings may be worn under the school uniform, but not as standalone bottoms.



At OCASA, our school uniform helps build a sense of community and belonging among students. It also reduces distractions and stress related to clothing choices or social pressures. When students wear the uniform consistently, it supports a learning environment where the focus stays on academics.
